


**Psalm 25:4-5, "Shew me thy ways, O LORD; teach me thy paths. Lead me in thy truth, and teach me: for thou art the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day."**



When I was a young girl, I would frequently walk in the woods on my parent's property. We lived in Tennessee surrounded by 300+ acres of wooded hills. Before going alone, I went frequently with my parents making mental notes of the path they took through the woods. There was no beaten path to follow; therefore the danger of getting lost was one I feared most.
