
Proverbs 28:26, "He that trusteth in his own heart is a fool: but whoso walketh wisely, he shall be delivered."



The numbers found in this reference are quite interesting when relating them to the verse. With our "2" feet we decide whom we will follow: our own heart or the heart of God.



Many times in the past we have used the number "8" to represent the lazy Christian whom is fat on themselves.



With this thought, the chapter "28" could represent the fat Christian who decides to follow his own heart when making decisions instead of going to God in prayer.

In the second part of this verse it talks about the wise man being delivered. Delivered from what? - His own foolishness and sin. The number "6" is used to represent sin and our fallen nature. With this thought, the verse "26" could represent the wise Christian who decides to follow the Lord and be delivered from sin.



Additional Verses:

Proverbs 3:5-7, "Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths. Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil."

Jeremiah 17:9-10, "The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it? I the LORD search the heart, I try the reins, even to give every man according to his ways, and according to the fruit of his doings."

Jeremiah 9:23-24, "Thus saith the LORD, Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, neither let the mighty man glory in his might, let not the rich man glory in his riches: But let him that glorieth glory in this, that he understandeth and knoweth me, that I am the LORD which exercise lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness, in the earth: for in these things I delight, saith the LORD."
