

Psalm 56:13, “For thou hast delivered my soul from death: wilt not thou deliver my feet from falling, that I may walk before God in the light of the living?”



Psalm 145:14, “The LORD upholdeth all that fall, and raiseth up all those that be bowed down.”

Psalm 37:23-24, “The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD: and he delighteth in his way. Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down: for the LORD upholdeth him with his hand.”

Think about the multiple times God has held you up and kept you from utterly falling. His compassion and forgiveness is astounding.

Psalm 116:8-9, “For thou hast delivered my soul from death, mine eyes from tears, and my feet from falling. I will walk before the LORD in the land of the living.”

Jude 24, “Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy,”

He is not only able to keep us from falling; He is able “to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him” (Hebrews 7:25). He is “able even to subdue all things unto himself” (Phil. 3:21). He is “able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think,” (Eph. 3:20).

Our God is all powerful. Why do we worry when we have Him by our side to keep us from falling?

2 Corinthians 1:9-10, “But we had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we should not trust in ourselves, but in God which raiseth the dead: Who delivered us from so great a death, and doth deliver: in whom we trust that he will yet deliver us;”

We cannot trust our flesh which has an appetite for wrong. But we can trust in our Heavenly Father who will help keep us along the way and help us in the battle with our flesh.

Job 33:26-30, "He shall pray unto God, and he will be favourable unto him: and he shall see his face with joy: for he will render unto man his righteousness. He looketh upon men, and if any say, I have sinned, and perverted that which was right, and it profited me not; He will deliver his soul from going into the pit, and his life shall see the light. Lo, all these things worketh God oftentimes with man, To bring back his soul from the pit, to be enlightened with the light of the living."

The greatest gift we have received from God is deliverance from an eternity in hell. In return, He asks us to serve Him and share this gift with others. What a simple price to pay for such a wonderful gift.

That I may walk before God in the light of the living.

Helping others see that God is real is our calling.

John 10:37-38, "If I do not the works of my Father, believe me not. But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in me, and I in him."

When doubts and confusion cloud the mind, people have difficulty with simple trust and belief. We must point them to the physical evidence and proof of His truth. Inside us is the living proof that He is real. Let's die to self and allow His Holy Spirit to shine through our lives.
